- Post your resume anonymously. Anonymous postings let you remove personal identifiers except an email address.
- Never put your social security number, date of birth, or other personal data on a resume.
- Don't agree online to a background check. You should first have a face-to-face interview, and give written consent.
- Don't pay up front for job placement. Most legitimate firms charge employers, not job-seekers.
